WHEN SHOULD I GIVE?

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 16:1-2 states, "Now about the collection for God's people: Do what I told the Galatian churches to do. On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made."

Comments: The early church gathered on "the first day of the week" and brought their offerings to the Lord. We are to give regularly and are instructed to give systematically. Paul was saying in effect, "don't let your offerings accumulate at home."

Application: Systematic, regular giving is what God expects. May the fact that we put God first in our lives be reflected in how we honor Him in our giving.
